


2011 General Fund Expenditures




2011 General Fund Receipts


Dei Fratelli, located in Northern Wood County, is the only canned tomato processor in the United States that does not use dehydrated or powered ingredients.






Foreclosure Property Sales



Unemployment Rate Drops


Ohio Not Seasonally Adjusted Unemployment Rates December 2011







Solid Waste Fee Revenue





Civil War Sesquicentennial


