

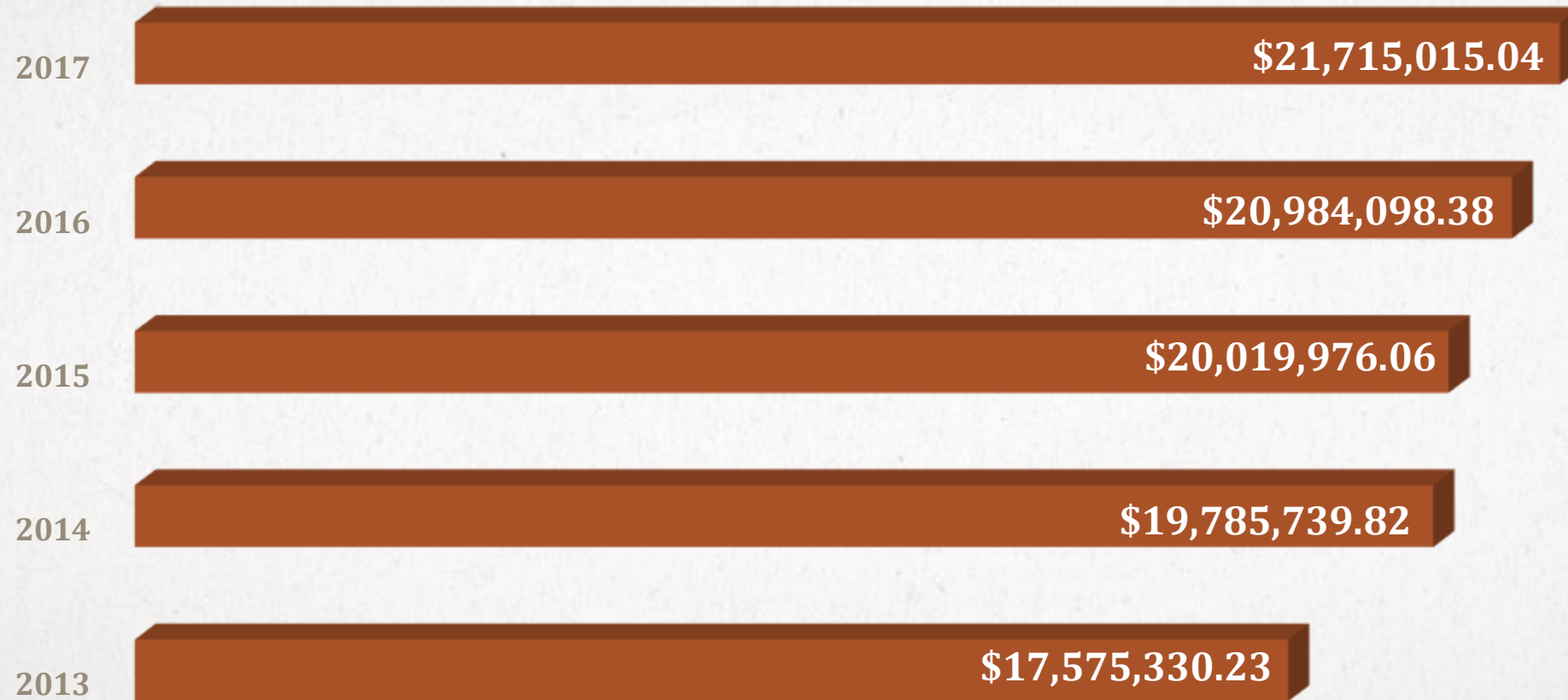

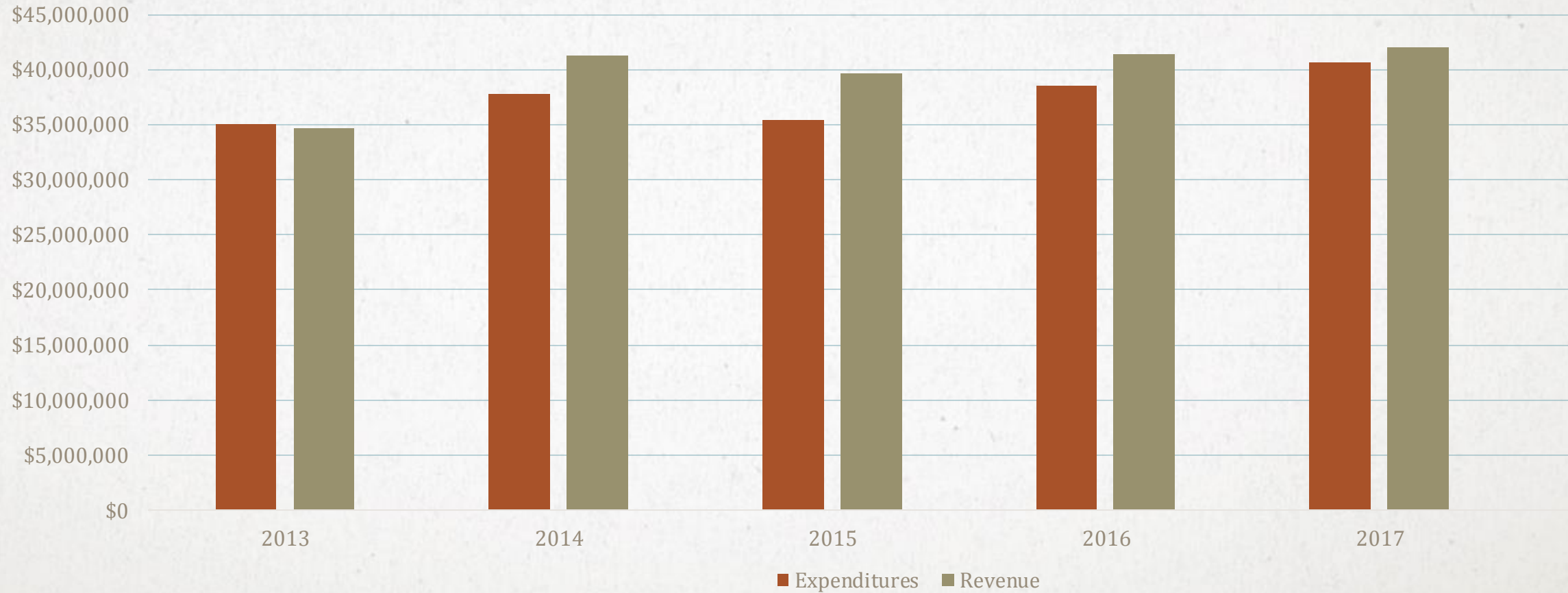




Sales Tax Receipts 2013 - 2017

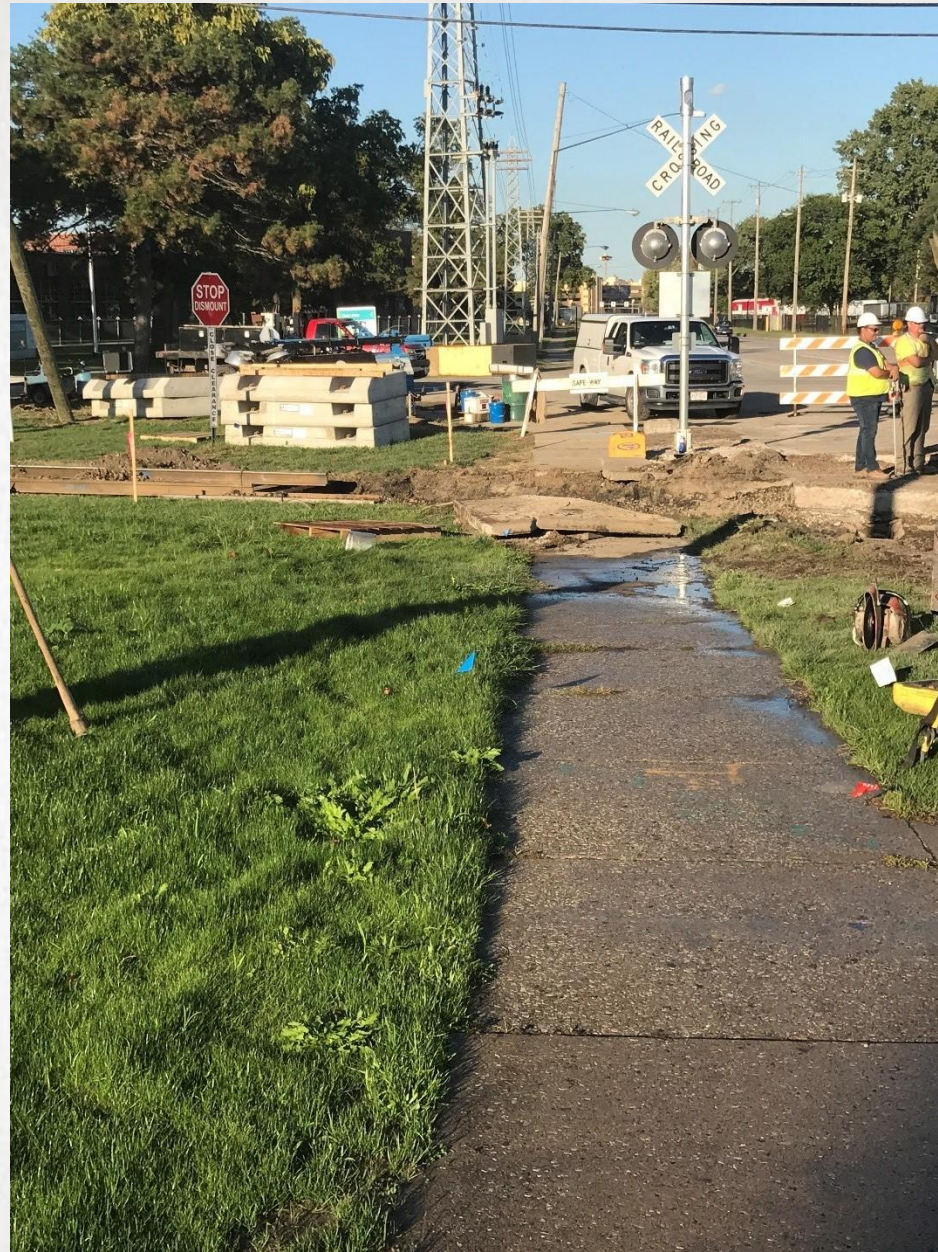

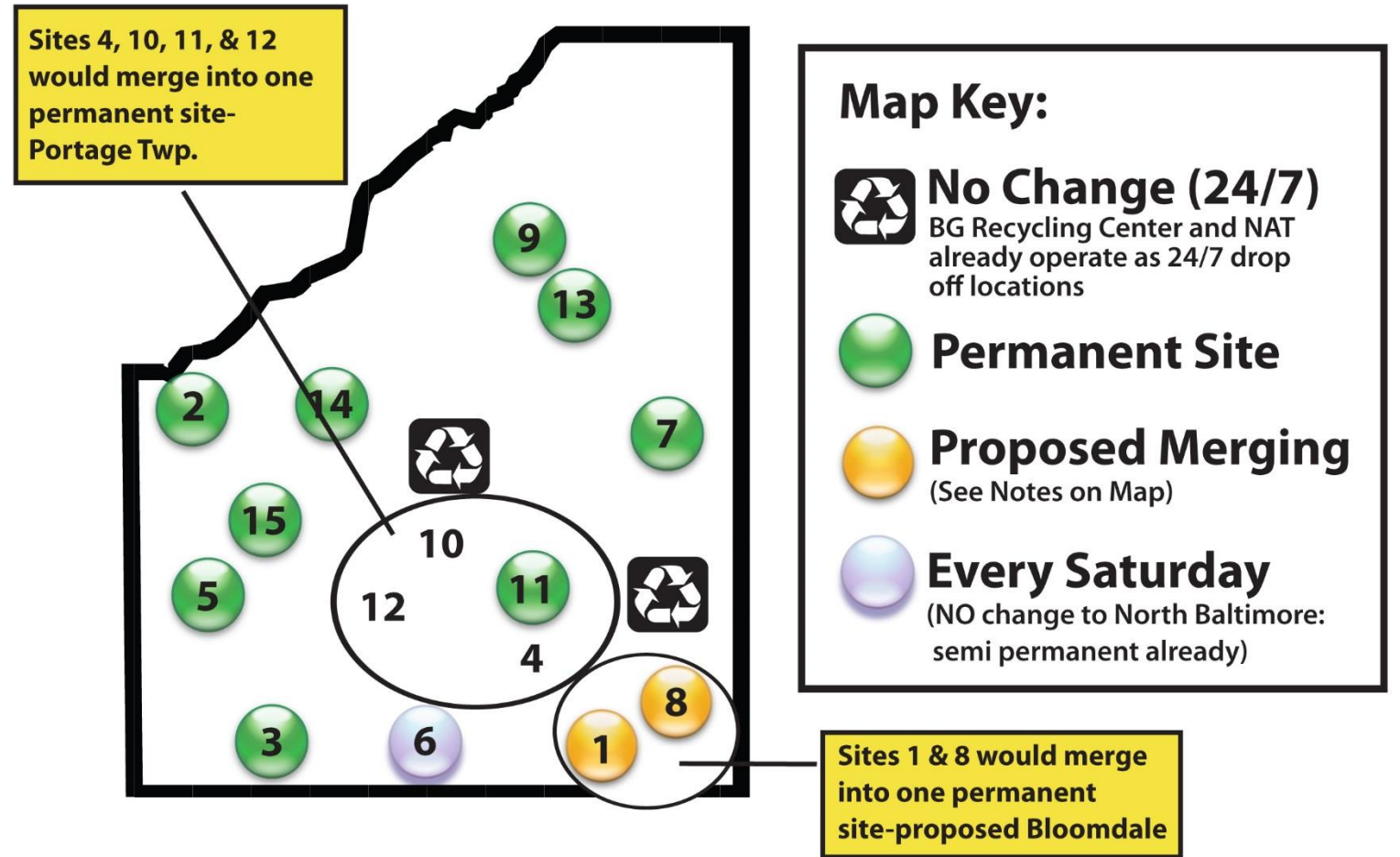


Glass recycling continues in the County thanks to a new agreement with the Bowling Green Recycling Center, City of Bowling Green, OH, and others.

The Power of a Penny!

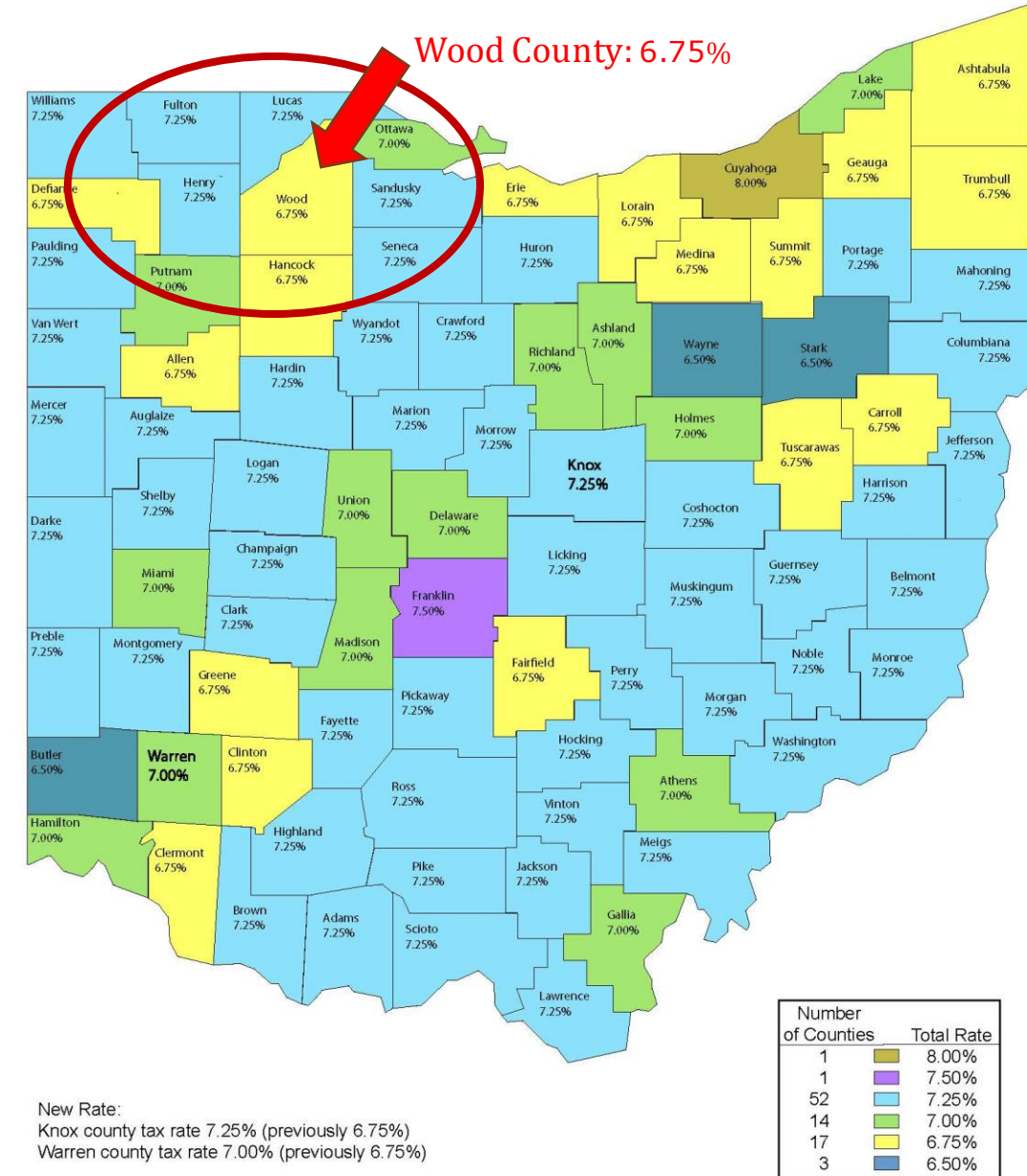


The primary source of funding to pay for the services of county government comes from our one penny sales tax.
