**Solid Waste (Garbage) • Mattresses  
Yard Waste • Bricks/ Rocks  
Construction & Demolition Materials  
Concrete • Dirt/ Asphalt  
Tires • Scrap Metal  
Furniture • Appliances**

## **MATERIALS NOT ACCEPTED!**

### **HAZARDOUS WASTE & CHEMICALS**

These items can cause fires, the decomposition of protective layers, or can get into leachate.

### **ELECTRONICS & BATTERIES**

Electronics cause many landfill fires, and batteries contain hazardous chemicals. TVs, laptops, phones, electric scooters, speakers, and anything else are prohibited!
